**Become a Volunteer Guide.** If you're interested in the history of Québec and/or Montréal, you'd be an ideal candidate! Complete training is provided. Paired with experienced guides, you'll learn the ins and outs of guiding and other activities, at your own pace.

### **Become a Friend of the Garden**

If you are interested in gardening and enjoy being outside and meeting people from all over, become a Friend of the Garden. From June 24 until Labour Day, our volunteers welcome visitors from all over the world with activities that help them learn more about the Governor's Garden, its history, the history of the Château and of Montréal in the 18th century. (The training for becoming Friends of the Garden is offered in French only.)

### **A Risky Business?**

In becoming a volunteer, you risk only making new friends! In addition to the Friends of the Garden, volunteer guides are grouped into two associations: the French-speaking guides and the English-speaking guides. Together, they total almost 100 members. Each group organizes ongoing training, activities and outings during the year. Some volunteers have been with the Château for 25 years or more.
